First of all, you should know that EuroTab is the educational committee of the European Feldenkrais organization. Its name stands for “Training Accreditation Board”, and as such, we are responsible for maintaining quality and content in professional training programmes, developing new projects and coordinating the educational standards with the three other international TAB’s (NaTAB, AusTAB, D-TAB).

GROUP AND COMMITTEMENT

The TAB is comprised of six members, that volunteer for a period of three years. There are two trainers, two assistant trainers, and two experienced practitioners including a chairman/woman.

Although the work on the EuroTAB is a voluntary work you do for the community, it’s important to prepare thoroughly, observe and respect deadlines, and inform the office and the whole group early enough when offline, or away.

Our regular work consists of reading and evaluating applications of assistant trainers, trainer candidates, and Trainers, accrediting training programmes and developing new standards for our growing community. These tasks involve discussion, interchange of opinions, problem solving and promoting new projects.

If you are a practitioner with experience and are interested in contributing to the quality of the method and also want to better understand the educational standards, we provide a pleasant working environment that requires about 10 hours monthly.
